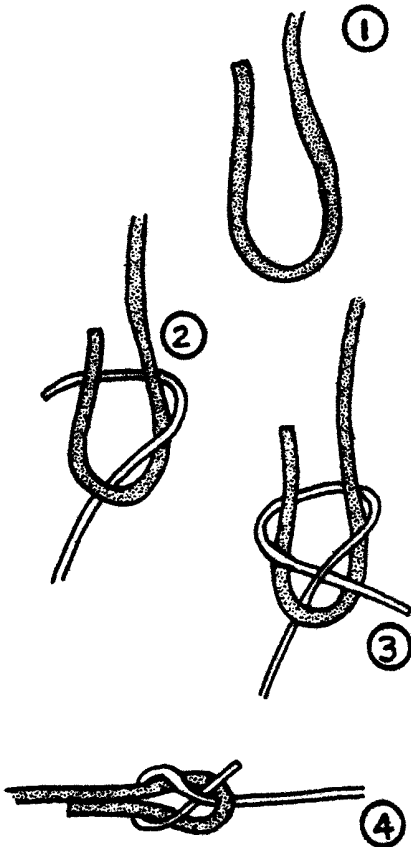


CUB PRO-PLAN CHART NO. 1.

THE SHEET BEND

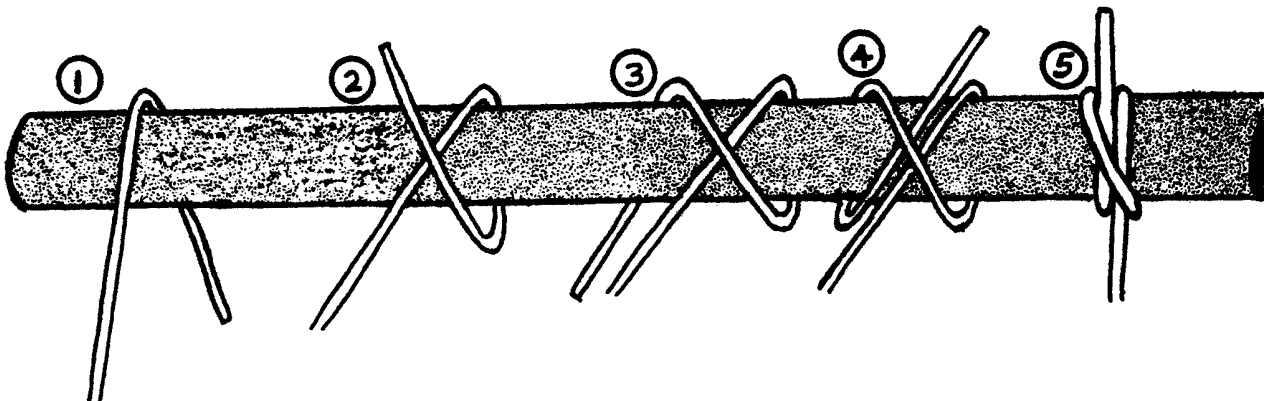


THE SHEET BEND IS USED FOR JOINING TWO ROPES.

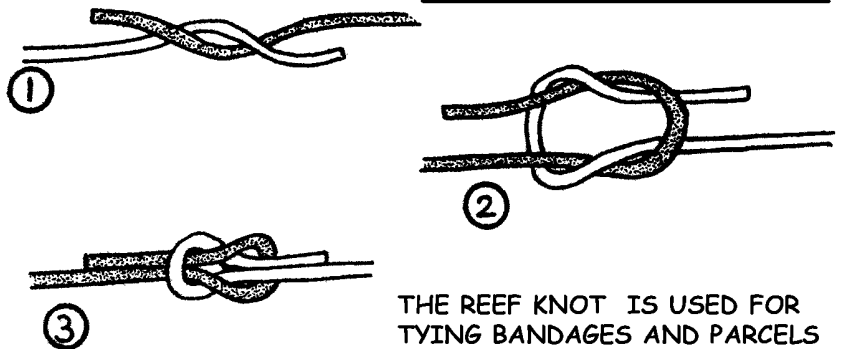
PULL ALL KNOTS TIGHT.

THE CLOVE HITCH

THE CLOVE HITCH IS USED TO TIE A ROPE TO A POLE.



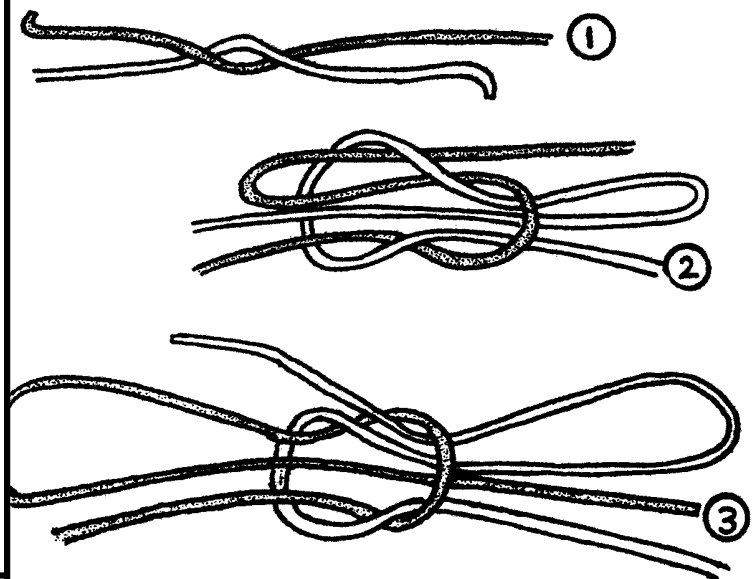
THE REEF KNOT



THE REEF KNOT IS USED FOR TYING BANDAGES AND PARCELS BECAUSE IT IS A FLAT KNOT AND WILL NOT SLIP.

PULL ALL KNOTS TIGHT.

THE SLIP REEF



THE SLIP REEF IS MADE LIKE AN ORDINARY REEF EXCEPT THAT THE ROPE OR STRING IS LOOPED BEFORE MAKING THE SECOND TIE. THIS MAKES A 'BOW' WHICH IS USED FOR TYING SHOE LACES.
