FIRE BUILDING

①

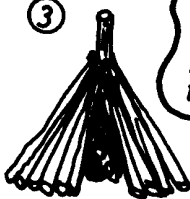


1 Start with a piece of wood standing upright and some form of kindling at the base

2 Next start a pyramid of twigs and slivers of wood. Leave an opening faced to the wind

3 Continue the pyramid, adding thicker wood

4 Finally add the heavy wood then light the fire through the opening provided.



THIS BASIC FIRE BUILDUP IS USED FOR ALL OTHER FORMS — SEE OTHER CHARTS

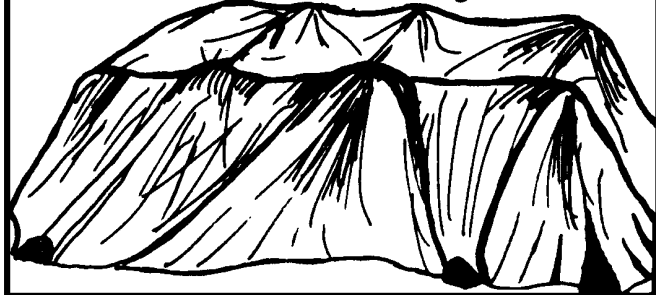
SAFETY RULES

- 1 CLEAR AREA AT LEAST 3 METRES ROUND FIRE.
- 2 CHOOSE A SAFE SITE.
- 3 DON'T MAKE A FIRE UNDER TREES.
- 4 PLACE FIRE DOWNWIND & WELL AWAY FROM THE WOODPILE.
- 5 DON'T LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENDED.
- 6 BUILD THE FIRE TO SUIT THE NEED
- 7 HAVE FIRE FIGHTING GEAR ON HAND
- 8 BE SURE THE FIRE IS OUT BEFORE LEAVING

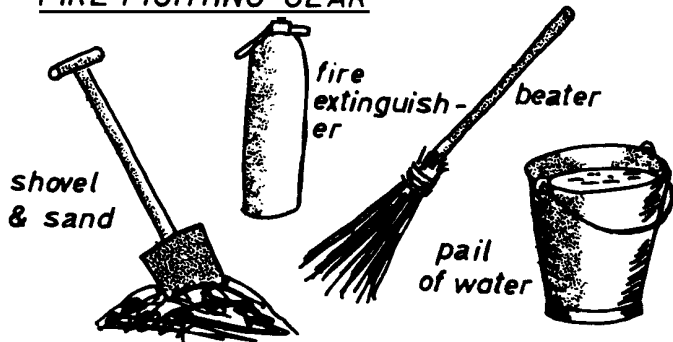
WOOD STORAGE
